The staff will learn the strengths and challenges of our math instruction. We will continue examining our instructional methods throughout the year as we continue to adjust to our students' needs.

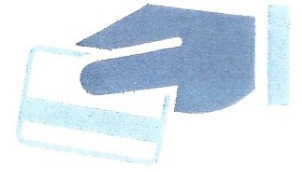
