## Drop off procedures on November 22, 2017

### Before Care

Brompton staff will be parking in the back of school. Parents dropping off for Before Care between 7:00 a.m and 7:45 a.m. will park outside **Door 17** only, run their children in to the cafeteria, sign them in and leave.

### Student drop off from 7:45 a.m. – 8:15 a.m.

School Messengers will be sent Monday and Tuesday reminding parents regarding our drop off procedures for Wednesday. Due to the bus being parked in the parent parking lot, parents will only be able to drop off students by Door 17. This is the best way to keep students safe while vehicles are entering and exiting for donation drop off. Extra patience and arriving early will be greatly appreciated. I will have two staff members holding signs at the entrance of the parking lot. They will be directing donations from the community to turn right in the lot and park. Students from Interact and Student Council will be helping unload their donations. **All Brompton Families will be ushered to turn left to drop off students. We will have many staff members outside opening car doors and assisting students out of vehicles to keep the line moving. Look for Mrs. Battle who will be waving a flag and standing at the far Eastern part of the drop off line. Please pull up as far as possible so we can continue to unload cars the whole stretch of the building. We are going to have a double drop off lane with staff members in the lot to help. Students should be ready to exit their cars right away. This should allow us to unload many cars at a time. Turning right out of the lot onto 22 Avenue will help the line moving so cars are not backed up trying to enter the lot. We are accepting students into the building on Wednesday starting at 7:45 a.m. at no charge for childcare. We will relax the tardy policy for the morning as students may not be able to enter school before 8:15 a.m. Students are to bring their donations with them. The classrooms will take the donations out as a group to the bus after school begins.**

**I understand that this is our first time doing this procedure and there will be changes that will need to be made for next year, but I appreciate your patience entering and leaving the parking lot. Student safety is our first concern. I will be directing traffic at the entrance to avoid accidents. Thank you for your donations, your patience and your support of our student civic leadership and service learning. This is an event that should make a positive impact for all of our students.**

I wish all of you a Happy and Healthy Thanksgiving holiday weekend. We have a lot to be thankful for at Brompton. The Wisconsin DPI school report card is scheduled for public release on Tuesday November 21, 2017. I will share the report card as soon as I have permission.
