### Treasurer's Report – Billy Weathersby

- Auction: Grand total gained was \$4,682.70; just short of \$5,000 goal. We even had some bidders not from Brompton.
- Spaghetti dinner: Raised \$2,536.00; \$400.00 was paid to Brat Stop/Parkway Chateau for use of the venue. Please let us know any suggestions for improvement; please feel free to e-mail anyone on the BCP board with ideas.
- Raffle Ticket sales came in at \$1,410.00
- Fall Fest= Raised \$1,402.61 in net profit.
- The Artworks Program has accrued \$1,603.75 in orders; we get a percentage of this, which is not know as of this time. Usually around 25% comes back to the school.
- The current BCP Register Report Net Total is \$13,477.00
- The Annual BCP Pledge Drive will be an all year event; a flyer to explain the program will be sent home in the near future. The donation amount can be of your choosing; **however, if every family donated just under \$20.00 we would reach our goal of 3,000.00.** If anyone's employer/company participates in a matching donation program, please sign up for the donation to go to Brompton, and let Billy Weathersby know your company participates. If you donate before the end of this year, it will count toward a deduction of your 2015 taxes.
