MAP, Access and PALS testing

Our students will begin their Winter round of assessments. These are important assessments for our school. Our teachers use the information to help each student grow in proficiency in reading and math with the goal of all of our students performing proficiently in March when they take the Wisconsin Forward exam. The Wisconsin Forward results are used as one component of our school report card. Please make sure your child is getting plenty of rest in December and January, eats a healthy breakfast and attends school on time every day.

Messages from area businesses
