Jump start to high school (0.5 credit) (Session 1 only)

- This course focuses on meeting the personalized learning needs of students by combining the academic components of math and reading with strategies for success in high school to help prepare students for their ninth grade classes. Upon successful completion of the course, students will earn a 0.5 elective credit.

PE Foundations (0.5 credit)

- The summer school physical education course operates just as it does during the regular school year – on a semester basis; each summer school session is equal to a semester. Upon successful completion of the course students will earn a 0.5 PE credit. Students are only allowed two absences.
